

Value Tuff Display Graphics

Your graphics are produced using the finest materials available, and are manufactured to yield the ideal balance of color richness, image detail, economy, overall appearance and life expectancy possible.

However, like any product involving quality craftsmanship, your full-color digital graphics are vulnerable to mishandling or inappropriate exposure which may damage the product.

Here are some tips to help you extend the useable life of your graphics:

All Graphics

- Do not fold, crease or scuff graphics.
- Do not store in extreme temperature or humidity.
- Unless your graphics are fabricated using UV-rated materials, do not expose to direct sunlight. Also limit exposure to any other UV light sources such as fluorescent.
- If your graphics are to be hung from the corners, sides or ends, do not stretch beyond a reasonable tension, as this may increase the likelihood of tearing in the event of wind, interference or falling objects.

Unlaminated

- Unless your graphics have been specified as moisture-resistant, protect the image surface from ALL moisture.
- Do not touch the image area with any object, or lay face-down.

Laminated Graphics

- Always roll image-side OUT. Do not roll to less than 3" diameter.
- Keep the edges of the graphics away from moisture.
- You may clean the LAMINATED image surface with a soft cloth and water; however, do not use solvent-based cleaners, or scrape or rub hard.

Mounted Graphics

- Avoid bumping edges against hard objects, as edges may chip or dent.
- Do not stand graphic on one of its corners.
- Do not set objects on or against image surface, as it may dent.
- Keep mounted graphics away from moisture, unless ALL materials used are rated moisture-resistant.
